The Kaddish is an ancient prayer which is recited by mourners. However, it is interesting to note that there is no mention of the deceased in this prayer. Rather it calls upon the congregation to praise and acknowledge G-d. This serves as a great merit for the deceased and atones for sins they may have done during their lifetime. By focusing on the greatness of Hashem, the mourner gains a sense that there is a spiritual realm. Although their loved one may have passed from this world, the soul remains forever. Additionally, Kaddish is only recited with a minyan. By identifying with the community the mourner gains the awareness that even if individuals may have passed on, Hashem's purpose will be fulfilled through the Jewish people.
